## Twin City Choristers To Unveil New 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary CD/DVD at Christmas Concert Nov. 30

**Winston-Salem, NC** – The Twin City Choristers, an all male performing choral group based in Winston-Salem, will unveil their new 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary *From the Heart* combination CD/DVD after their Annual Christmas Concert to be held Sunday, Nov. 30, at 4 p.m. in Dillard Auditorium of the Albert H. Anderson Conference on the campus of Winston-Salem State University.

The concert, which is free and open to the public, is under the direction Dr. Fred D. Tanner and accompanied by Travis Horton. Musical selections will include a combination of traditional Christmas classical works, as well as more contemporary works with an international flair.

The Choristers newest CD/DVD, *From the Heart*, is a tribute to the late Permylla Flack Dunston, who founded the group in 1957 and was its first director. The Choristers had hoped to perform the concert in Dr. Dunston's presence, but unfortunately Dr. Dunston passed in October 2006. The concert was performed a year later in her honor.

*From the Heart* not only captures the exciting performance of the October 2007 anniversary concert, but also provides a history of the group as told by some of the original members and much more.

The Choristers have performed in churches, schools and concert halls in and around Winston-Salem, throughout North Carolina, and done concert tours to New Jersey, Pennsylvania, New York, and Connecticut. As members of the mainstream arts community in Winston-Salem, the Choristers have participated in concerts with the Winston-Salem Symphony, the Piedmont Chamber Singers, and Winston-Salem State University.

In addition to their new CD/DVD, available for a donation of \$20, the Choristers will also have available their two CDs currently on the market, *Reflections*, recorded in 2004 and *Christmas With The Twin City Choristers*, recorded in 2005. Both of these CD are available for a donation of \$10 each.

The Chorister organization is one the newest member groups of The Arts Council of Winston-Salem and Forsyth County.
